How to make a capuchin knot for jewebry?

Discover in this video how to make a capuchin knot for a bracelet. Very simple to make, this knot is a stopper knot or a knot to fix a carabiner.

We advise you to make this knot with <u>elastic nylon thread</u> but also with $\underline{\text{cotton thread}}$ and $\underline{\text{leather thread}}$. You can make the capuchin knot on the $\underline{\text{shackle}}$.

We explain other knot techniques in the video: for example $\underline{\text{how to make a sliding knot}}$, $\underline{\text{how to make a large double}}$ $\underline{\text{knot with a ribbon}}$ or $\underline{\text{how to make a surgeon's knot with elastic thread}}$.



Which material to use for Capuchin Node?

Braided nylon thread 1mm Rose Peach x3m

Sterling silver round beads 4 mm gold plated x25

steps



Take a piece of yarn and fold it in half.



Step 2/6

Make a loop around your index finger.



Step 3/6

Thread the ends of the wires through the loop once, then a second time.



Step 4/6

Pull to form your capuchin knot.



Step 5/6

Form your bracelet into a round shape. Tie a capuchin knot on one side using your tube. This time, you'll need to wrap the tube around the wire on which the knot will slide. Finish your knot and tighten. Then do the same on the other side. Test your bracelet and adjust the position of the knots.



Step 6/6

Cut the piece of wire to within 1 mm of the knot, then melt it with a lighter or wire burner. Make sure the piece of wire is melted onto the knot.
