How to make a braided bracelet with beads?

How to make a braided bracelet with pearls?

In this tutorial video learn how to make a Brazilian bracelet and insert pearls in the weaving of your bracelet . They will bring a touch of originality to your friendship bracelets!

Realizable on a cuff as on a fine bracelet this technique is applicable on all your knotted bracelets .

For the manufacture of this Brazilian chevron bracelet with pearls you will need:

- Scissors for cutting your cotton threads .
- <u>Masking tape</u> to wedge your bracelet to make your knots easier. Or even better, a <u>micro macrame tray</u>.
- Fine <u>copper wire</u> to thread your pearls
- Cotton thread to make your Brazilian bracelet .
- A <u>button</u> to finish your bracelet and attach it to your wrist.

The Brazilian beaded bracelet will bring femininity and originality to your creations. Make bracelet borders with seed beads to enhance the simplest of your bracelets!

Tutorial's steps



★ Step 1/5

Cut 130 cm (52 in) of 5 embroidery threads in the color of your choice. Join them together to find the middle. Tie your threads together to form a

Attach your threads to the table with a piece of masking tape.






* Step 2/5

Arrange your threads symmetrically. You need to divide each of the colors into two parts like in a mirror.

In our tuto, we have 1 green thread, 1 purple thread, 1 pink thread, 1 lilac thread, 1 blue thread, then 1 blue thread, 1 lilac thread, 1 pink thread, 1 purple thread and 1 green thread.





** Step 3/5

Take the rightmost one (here the green wire), pass it over the purple wire


Take the rightmost one (here the green wire), pass it over the purple wire forming a loop.

Then pass the green wire under the purple wire. Pull the green wire through the loop to make a knot.

Repeat this step a second time.

Continue to tie your green thread in the same way with the other threads, to the right until you reach the middle.

Tie a knot with the middle wires (the two green wires).





* Step 4/5

Repeat the previous step with all your wires.







Continue tying your threads, and when your bracelet has reached the desired wrist size, use the two middle threads to add a button. Do under the button with all the other wires to hold it in place. Add a little glue to secure it and trim the excess wires. And there you have it, all you have to do is attach your bracelet to your wrist.
