First of all, it is necessary to realize a gradient of colors, then to change the direction of the gradient and finally to make a reduction and a shaping of the target canes. steps

★ Step 1/6

Cut the different colors of polymer clay. Roll them into rods.

Lay the strands next to each other in the desired color gradation. Roll to secure them together. Then run through the rolling mill once.

★ Step 2/6

Shift the alignment of your stripes only 2 or 3 times. Make about 15 passes through the pasta machine.

★ Step 3/6

To remove surface paste deposits, use a flexible blade.

★ Step 4/6

Switch to the finest notch.

★ Step 5/6

Roll the ribbon of dough around itself.

★ Step 6/6

Trim the ends to give your duck a nice shape.
