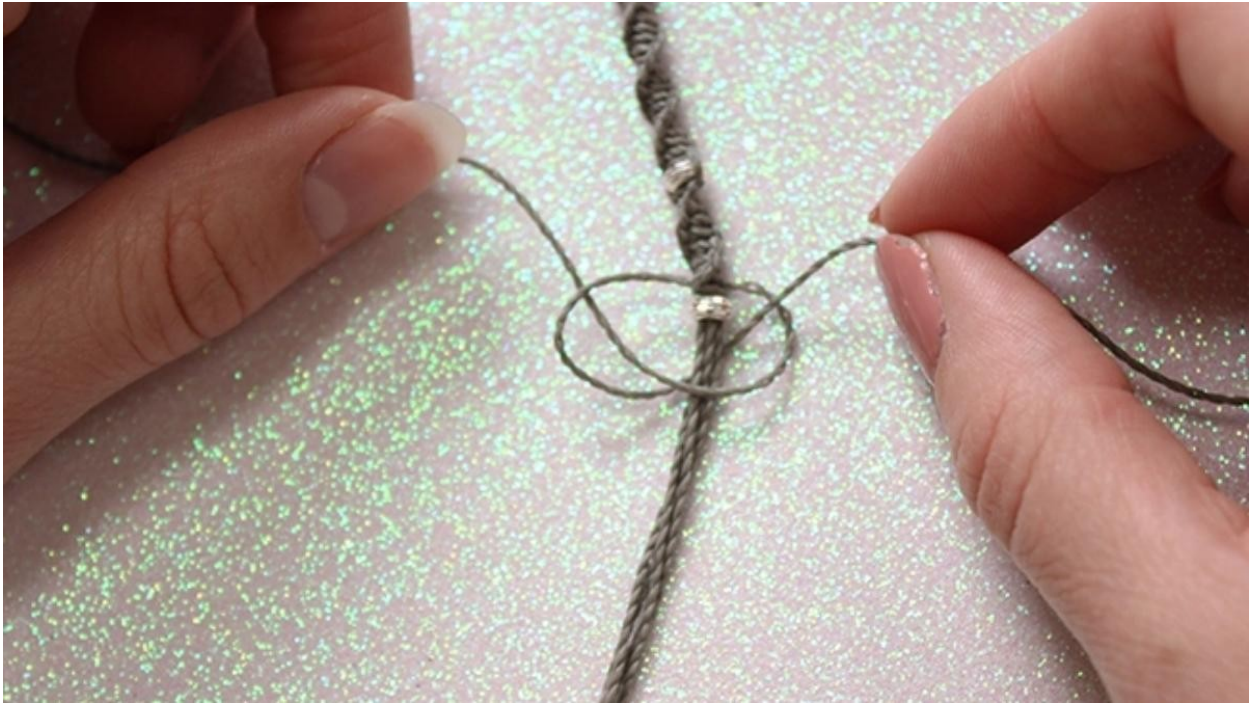

- the Moorish head knot : 00:08:03
