


WHAT TO DO IN MACRAME? - 10 DIY DECOR IDEAS

What is macramé? Macramé is a traditional weaving technique based on the creation of different knots with thread or rope. These macramé knots can be flat, as in the case of wall weaving, or in volume, to make decorative objects such as plant hangers or cushions.

What's more, it's an activity that requires very little investment in materials. All you need is macramé wire, a pair of scissors, macramé pins, decorative elements... a dash of creativity and a little patience.
