It is a polymer clay that is malleable, easy to work with and hardens once it is baked. There is a wide range of Fimo clay with many colors and various effects, which can even be mixed together: Fimo effect, Fimo professional, Fimo soft, Fimo air, Fimo liquid and Fimo kid.

What can we do with Fimo paste? The possibilities are numerous in the creation of jewelry as necklaces, bracelets, earrings, rings ... but also decorative objects and accessories such as key chains, small figurines, characters Kawaii ... But it can also be used to personalize objects by sticking on small elements made by you.

Before you start, you need to know some basics: what tools for Fimo paste? How to store its Fimo paste? How to sand, polish and gloss polymer clay? How to bake the clay fimo?

- Unique and original peony flower earrings to sublimite a blouse or a white dress.
- A gemstone effect necklace, imitating tinted howlite stones. Lighter than natural stone beads, these beads in Fimo paste are pleasant to wear.
- Pegs shaped letters of the alphabet to hang bags, coats, jackets, scarves or hats. They will be perfect in a child's room.
- Ultra trendy zebra pattern earrings. They will allow you to add an animal touch to your look!



- Flat creoles with a marbled pattern. Mix the colors according to your desires for more pop creations or in a delicate cameo.
- A flower pendant in relief. It is ideal for beginners who want to learn polymer clay.
- Customized jar lids in Zero Waste mode. You will be able to store in a stylish way foods like sugar, coffee, candies.
