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Soft textures

Touch is important in this Danish art of living. Surrounding yourself with soft materials is also very hygge. We think of soft materials such as veryet, fake fur, wool... so many materials that can be used in 100% DIY creations for decorative objects (cushion, plaid, blanket, etc.).









9- Vintage has its place
Hunting, renovating old family furniture, up-cycling, these are all activities that fit into the hygge concept.
So grab your brushes and paints and start renovating the family furniture you left in your garage or attic. With a little elbow grease, you'll get a custom piece of furniture.

10- Stock up on blankets and pillows
Comfort and softness are inherent in hygge. One simple and easy thing to do is to position blankets and pillows in your home. What's better than curling up in a blanket on a cool summer evening or winter day?

Make your pillows, sew your blankets with soft and warm materials such as fleece, faux fur, flannel or boiled wool.
