How to organize your hobby workshop?

March 21, 2022 is the international day of office tidying. This day is a great opportunity to sort out your workshop and reorganize your desk, because we know that many of you take advantage of every moment to create! Beads, clips and charms accumulate on your workspace until nothing more can be added. Then it's time for a big tidy up! In any case, this is what happened to our designer Tiffanie who spends every minute of her time at Perles and Co concocting new tutorials. Great words, great remedies! A few boxes to store the threads and beads, an extra shelf and a good day of tidying up later, Tiffanie is ready to create again with more serenity! Find out which storage solutions for beads she chose for her office. Maybe it will give you some ideas.

1 - shelves to store jewelry clips and wires

At Perles and Co we offer several ideas for storage for your office. It is difficult to find furniture adapted to hobby equipment in the public domain. These small shelves that fit on a dresser or desk will allow you to store your pliers and spools of wire in an accessible and practical way. You can also put your beading trays or micro-macramé trays. The metal bar allows you to slide hollow spools in the center and thus unwind the wire easily without it getting tangled. Most of our wired yarns also have small holes so they can be hung from the shelf hooks. These hobby half shelves are a real time saver!



2 - Stackable and Adaptable Compartment Boxes

Sometimes it's hard to find boxes that fit exactly the size of the materials you want to store. The ideal is then boxes with adjustable dividers. Below are a few such storage boxes. The different levels of the box can be clipped together for even more adaptability and space saving.



3 - Bead storage boxes

There are many bead storage boxes on our site. Here are 3 storage solutions that you will appreciate. These boxes can also be used to store your primers. You can mix primers of the same finish (stainless steel, gold filled, gold filled etc.) together to save space. Remember to label the boxes with the product references so that you can find them on our site and read the details on the product sheet. Some boxes already have labels available, for the others, you can use small colored stickers for example. Avoid mixing primers that are too similar to be easily distinguished. For example, mix 2 and 5 mm rings, but not 4 and 5 mm.
