1 - A unique pen

2 - G graduated ruler

Another must-have school kit accessory: the graduated ruler. For maths, geometry, drawing, French... Use it to draw lines, organize lessons, underline key words in lessons, keep notebooks clean and attractively presented... Often transparent and colorless for the basic models, they deserve a little pimpering to bring some fun into the school kit. Create a <u>graduated ruler</u> in resin and personalize it according to your children's tastes. Add dyes, sequins, microbeads, dried flowers, stickers... and you're all set!

3 - a fabric kit

Attention budding and experienced seamstresses! Make a unique <u>fabric pencil case</u> for your child to keep all the pencils lying around on his desk (and all over his room). What's more, you can personalize it with your child's favorite fabric color.





4 - a personalized notebook cover

Protecting notebooks with a notebook cover is a bit (always!) the same hassle every time school starts. Uniform, unicolored, cardboard or plastic, nothing crazy. Why not make your own? A little resin in a <u>silicone mold</u> to make the notebook covers, flashy colors, glitter, vacation souvenirs... Let your imagination run wild!

5 - a personalized bookmark

Older children will certainly have a book (or several) to read. And to help them stay on the page, the ideal solution is to make them a unique resin bookmark: funny stickers, pictures of their superheroes, small objects to resin, dried flowers, original colors... Place everything in the silicone mold to create a rectangular bookmark, pour in the resin and let the magic happen. Customize with pearls, chain or pompoms... and you've got a stylish bookmark.
