Gemstiones are on trend this winter! There are many choices: cool colors with Moonstone or Lapis Lazuli, warm colors with Carnelian, Tiger's Eye or Amethyst, or soft colors with Aventurine, Crazy Agate and Labradorite.

Winter is the perfect season to explore a varied palette of natural stones. From icy hues that evoke snowy landscapes to warm colors that warm up outfits, each gemstone brings its own unique character. Opalite, Amazonite, Red Jasper, Smoky Quartz... We tell you which gemstones to choose to be on trend this winter!

Stones with cold, icy colors

Winter means cold (unless you're lucky enough to be exiled to the tropics...)! And to match the winter chill, we recommend gemstones in cold colors. White, blue, transparent, indulge yourself with these icy tones When it comes to gemstones, you'll love:

• Moonstone: with its milky-white reflections that recall the sparkle of snow in winter light. As a cabochon or pendant, it pairs well with gold to bring out the warmth, or with silver to enhance the icy effect.

• Lapis Lazuli: an intense blue, sometimes dotted with golden sparkles, evoking a starry winter sky. Mixed with freshwater or mother-of-pearl beads, it becomes the perfect jewelry centerpiece for winter!

You can also add a cool yet gentle touch with Rose Quartz or Aguamarine components.



Stones in warm colors

To contrast with the cold tones of winter, add a touch of color to your DIY jewelry. How do you do it? With colorful gemstones that will transform a basic creation into a hyper-trendy piece!

For winter, we recommend:

• Carnelian: it brings vitality and energy thanks to its warm shades ranging from orange to red-brown, a welcome contrast in cold weather. Whether you wear it on a discreet bracelet, as a cabochon on a ring or in a pair of earrings, these pretty natural stones will bring warmth and comfort.

• Tiger's eye: Tiger's eye seduces with its shimmering reflections and earthy hues reminiscent of warm autumn colors. This fine brown stone pairs well with gold finishes for a vintage look. Amethyst or pink-tinted Regalite: why choose them in winter? They'll liven up your creations in the blink of an eye! Just the thing to warm up gloomy winter days.







Stones in soft colors

For winter, we also like soft, soothing colors. Choose colors ranging from light green to cream and natural hues. Among gemstones, formerly known as semi-precious stones, we recommend

• <u>Aventurine</u>: with its pale green color, this is a resolutely soothing gemstone. It goes very well with other stones such as Tourmaline or Moonstone for soft DIY jewelry.
• <u>Crazy Agate</u>: seduces with its swirling patterns and colors ranging from creamy white to delicate caramel. In necklaces, bracelets or earrings, this fine stone adds a much-appreciated natural, handcrafted dimension.

· Labradorite: the perfect soft hue for winter. Whether combined with gold, silver or colored components, Labradorite always stands out for its singular, charming colors
