

KNOT BROOCH IN BRICK STITCH WEAVING

Diagram :
To begin, you should start with a simple model that will teach you to increase and decrease.

Row 1 :
Step 1 :
Cut about 3m thread and slip a needle at both ends.
Thread the first bead of the row 1 of the diagram and lock it in the middle of your thread crossing it.



Step 2 :
Slip the second bead and cross the thread.



Step 3 :
Repeat the step 2 for all the first row.



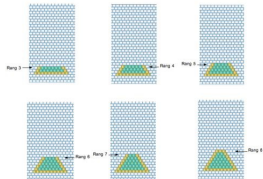
Row 2 :
Step 4 :
Decrease at the beginning and end of the rows . A single needle is enough. Slip the first bead of the row2 then pass the needle under the thread that is between the first 2 beads from the first row and slip back the needle once again in the bead



The bead is positioned on the 2nd row between the 2 first bead of the row 1.

Row 3 - 8 :

Step 5 :
Proceed in the same way . You decrease in a half place at each row.



At the end of the row , the decreasing is easier.

Row 9 :

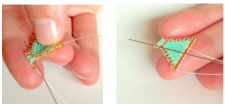
Step 6 :
Increasing at the beginning and the end of the row.



The increases at the beginning of row : thread together the first two beads of the row. Go under the wire connecting the first two beads of the previous row, and then pass the thread in the second to lock.



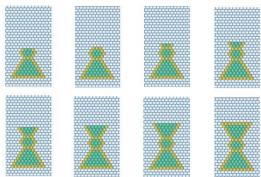
The increases at the end of the row : place the last bead of your row and always proceed the same way but this bead has no attachment, attach between the last two beads from the previous row.



Row 10 :



Row 11-19 :



Hide the thread in your beads and cut it . Fix on a pin or a brooch .
well done!

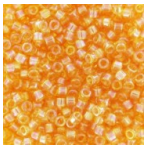

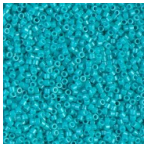
