How to make macramé coasters?

How to make macrame coasters?

Easy little DIY this summer : macrame coasters. This is an essential macrame tutorial! Make coasters and trivets in different colors of macrame yarn to match your decor. It is also an easy and cheap macrame gift idea .

You can use several different macrame threads to make them. In this Facebook Live of May 29, 2020 we present you different types of macrame ropes .

For the macrame coaster strings you can use a [Natura XL DMC cotton ball](#) or [30x supercotton](#). Each will allow you to create 4 coasters 9 to 10 cm in diameter without counting the fringes. They come in many different colors.

For the [tutus](#) for the teapot, we used the [Big Design creative cotton cord macrame cord](#) with which you can make a macrame trivet 13 to 15 cm in diameter without counting the fringes. You can also use the recycled cotton cord for macrame from DMC NOVA VITA but be careful you will not be able to create fringes with it. However, you can make a crochet trivet with, a basket or a macrame plant hanger.

Macrame interests you but you do not know the knots. Find the [11 basic macrame knots in video](#) . In this tutorial we only use 2 knots: the lark knot and the tating knot.



1. For the trivet cut 5x1m and 1x2m of rope and for the coasters 5x60cm and 1x2m.
2. Fold the 5 smaller strings in half by their half and line them up on a column.
3. Fold the long rope in half but in 1/3 2/3 then place it on top of the 5 others with the loop up.
4. Tie the 5 ropes one by one to the two strands of the large rope with a lark's knot.
5. Then pass the ends of the large rope through the loop and tighten to form a circle with the lark's knots.
6. You will then tie knots with the small ropes around the longer rope starting with the right rope. Tie a wand knot with it on the long rope.
7. Continue to tie wand knots with the strings and add a new string to the large string with a lark's knot if the space between the strings becomes too large.
8. Continue until you have the desired length.
9. Once finished, tighten the last knot well. Cut the ropes so that they form a harmonious circle then separate the ends of the rope with a comb to make the fringes. Trim as needed.
