

PHILODENDRON LEAF EARRINGS POLYMER CLAY AND PASTELS

Step 1: Put 2 pieces of polymere clay Fimo gold into the pasta machine at the wides With a cutter, out 2 hearts in the come size.





Step 2: Take 2 <u>dry pastels chalk</u> in 2 differents green tones. With a <u>blade</u> screpe them to obtain powder. Color the leaf with the durker green on the edges and work it with you fingers . Pastel should not enter in the veins of the leafs



Step 3: Take half a ber of <u>polymere clay Cemit orange</u> and put it in the pasta machine at the brightest With the 11 mm <u>Kemper-cutter</u> take off 2 circle and make 2 beads with them. Drill the leaves and the beads.

Step 5: If the crange bead and the <u>small becaze bead</u> on a <u>round head pin</u> and with a <u>round eller</u> form a loop at the other side. (Reminder: <u>How the shape a loop</u>)
