How to make a Miyuki pearl bead?

Don't worry, this weaving technique is very easy! If you are a beginner, it is still better to start with a flat Brick Stitch weaving to understand how this technique works. Once you have mastered the Brick Stitch, you will also automatically master the tubular Brick Stitch because it is the same technique with the simple difference that your pearl base is a circle.

Here are some tutorials to train you in Brick Stitch weaving:

• Miyuki diamond weaving bracelet with adjustable clasp

You can also create necklaces with this pearl weaving technique. Be careful however if you try to make a weaving with a larger diameter. By bending the weaving, a pressure is exerted, which, if it is too strong, risks breaking the pearls. This tension is a little stronger when making a weaving with a larger diameter, it is then necessary that the curvature is less important. Weaving grid Bracelet Brick Stitch tube:



- 1. Start by creating a base of 6 pearls in ladder stitch.
- 2. Then connect the first and last pearl with a loop.
- 3. Start weaving row 2 by making a raise with two beads.
 4. Go around row 2 then connect the first and last with a loop also before going to row 3 and repeating steps 3 and 4.
- 4. Go around row 2 then connect the first and last with a loop also before going to row 3 and repeating steps 3 and 4.

 5. Repeat the pattern as many times as necessary to have a bracelet to your size. You can also shorten it at the ends if ever adding a whole pattern will make your bracelet too big. Here we have repeated the pattern 6 times.

 6. Put a generous dose of jewelry glue in the end caps and push the ends of the tube into it, turning it a little so that the glue distributes well. Leave to dry for 2 hours.

 7. Once the glue is well set, carry out the assembly by adding the extension chain and the clasp with open rings.

 And here is your Miyuki pearl summer bracelet is ready! We advise you to wear it in stacking with other colored bracelets or weekly gold filled bracelets.
