#### How to make a 3D weaving in Miyuki Delicas?

Today find the last tutorial of one of the winners of our contest launched during confinement: "Weave your green plant" Anne Sophie alias [My Little Finger DIY](#) has prepared this pretty Plant-Pinou video. Mi succulent mi lapinou we completely fell for its creation (and you too, many of you have reacted), so we suggest the tutorial!

In the video, Anne-Sophie explains the basic method for weaving in 3D with a different color for each row. So you can make each sheet with the colors of your choice and weave other projects!

According to this method, here are the elements to weave to make the plant:

- 1 pistil
- 3 nano leaves
- 3 small leaves
- 6 medium leaves
- 6 large leaves

For the rabbit:

- 2 ears
- 2 pattoues

For the rabbit pot, weave a ?bracelet? in the loom according to the diagram below.



Details of the references used

Rabbit:

MATTE WHITE PEEL DB0200

FACE (AND HEART OF THE PLANT PISTIL): HEX CUT DBC0007 - METALLIC BROWN IRIS CUT

EARS: DB1524 - MATTE PALE PINK PALE

CONTOUR: DB0433 - GALVANIZED CHAMPAGNE

Leaves, from the inside of the sheet to the outside:

DB1268 - MAT TRANSPARENT CARIBBEAN TEAL

DB1586 - OPAQUE MAT SEA OPAL

DB1526 - MATTE OPAQUE LIGHT MINT

DB0868 - MAT TRANSPARENT PINK MIST

DB0356 - MATTE OPAQUE LIGHT MAUVE

DB1376 - DYED OPAQUE ANTIQUE ROSE

For mounting:

Step 1: Form the bracelet in the round by knotting the wires together.

Step 2: Hang the ears on each side of the face and the legs below by sewing them into the beads of the bracelet.

Step 3: Gather the sheets in order of size. Sew the same size sheets together in the round.

Step 4: Overlay in order of size then sew them together by stitching into the leaves. Be careful to make the thread invisible by stitching between the beads or in the beads.

And now, your plant is ready, and this one, no risk of forgetting to water it.

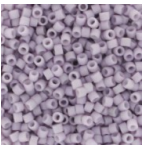

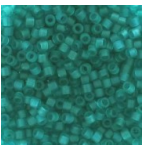

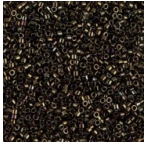
