

## COWRIE SHELL BRACELET COVERED WITH GOLD LUREX EMBROIDERY THREAD

Make your summer bracelet with natural cowrie and golden thread! Seashells are always there in this season to decorate our jewelry and give us a little holiday air, add a few strands of golden threads and a white macrame clasp to have all the elements together to create a nice bracelet. You can take other cowrie sizes as well as different colors of [cowrie shells](#).

Step 1  
Cut 3 m of thread then pass your needle to the middle, fold the thread in half then make a double knot with the ends. With this length of wire you can cover about 3 cowries, you can also take less wire and cover them one by one and then assemble them. Pass your thread in a cowrie then in the loop formed by the rest of the threads, surround the end of the shell several times by passing through it.



2nd step  
Surround the thinnest part of the cowrie entirely, finish by making several knots. Pass a pearl on the wire. Make a triple knot on the other side of the pearl, iron in the pearl, the first cowrie and then again in the pearl.



Step 3  
Pass a pearl on the wire. Make a triple knot on the other side of the pearl, iron in the pearl, the first cowrie and then again in the pearl. Pass your needle through a second cowrie, so it's like the first, do not hesitate to make several knots to consolidate the bracelet.



Step 4  
Continue to cover your cowrie shells with golden thread and place them one after the other until around your wrist, leaving a little bit of space between the shells to make room for a clasp. Take 2 lengths 20 cm of macrame thread, pass each thread through the last cowries and tie a knot.



Step 5  
Cross the 2 threads that you have just passed in the last cowries then for more ease for them with stretch tape on a support. Cut a new length of 20 cm of flat knot in the center of the threads that we just crossed. You must make 4 flat knots, the flat knot is a basic knot for the macrame technique you will find [here](#) all the explanations to do it.



Step 6  
Once your knots are finished, cut the wires leaving 2 mm then burn them and make sure by pressing while it is hot to solder them to the knot. This knot is sliding, adjust the length of the other threads to be able to pass your hand through the bracelet, also make a knot at each end then burn what exceeds.
