

For those who are fond of pearl weaving, we suspect that the odd peyote technique has no secrets for you, and for beginners, don't worry, our technical sheet: How to make an odd peyote weave is here to give you a boost. Pssst, have you seen our latest Perles & Co exclusive weaving tips introduced? Of all sizes, shapes, and colors, there is something for everyone.

Before you start, here is the diagram and color palette you will need to weave this lovely bracelet. Tip: To adjust the size of the bracelet to your wrist, it is advisable to start weaving from the center of the diagram.

Here we go! The stages: Step 1: This bracelet is woven using the odd peyote technique. Start by weaving the bracelet from the center of the diagram so that you can center the pattern and adjust the size of the bracelet to your wrist and as you weave. Step 2: Attach the golden metal tips to your weave. You can take the golden thread for this. For those who do not know how, refer to this tutorial, in which the technique is explained: Miyuki bracelet with peyote weaving tips Step 3: Add the extension chain to one side of the bracelet using an open ring and your pilers (but the extension chain if necessary to adjust the bracelet to your wrist). At the end of the chain add the mini yellow pompom. On the other side, attach the clasp in the same way as the chain on the first side.

There you go, your bracelet is finished! So, what do you think?
