

HEART PENDANTS IN MIYUKI DELICAS 15 BRICK STITCH TECHNIQUE

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Intermediate



30 minutes



How to weave beads around a pendant?

Weaving Miyuki beads around a pendant or a hollow out shape is much easier than it looks. Even if it is easier to know Brick Stitch weaving to achieve this tutorial, it is still accessible to beginners with good eyesight and good dexterity because the beads used are very small. Indeed, to keep the delicate aspect of the heart pendants, we used delicas and Miyuki seed beads size 15/0 which is the smallest size available. You can of course try with 11/0 beads.

1. Cut 60 cm of thread, thread it on a needle and attach the end to the heart pendant, leaving 15 cm of end of the thread. Thread 2 white delicas beads, place them near the knot. Wedge them with your finger, pass the thread under the pendant thread and return to the second bead on the side from which the thread comes out. Tighten.

2. Go through the first bead and return to the seconds os as to form a loop between the two beads and tighten them against each other.

3. Thread a third bead, place it against the second, wedge it with your finger and pass the thread under the pendant then in the bead and tighten. Continue to weave all of the beads as well. There are 32 white pearls around the small heart and 41 pearls around the big one.

4. For the small heart, place yourself in the sixth bead from the center (between the two curves). The wire should come out of the bead on the outside of the pendant. If this is not the case, pass the wire under the pendant and return to the bead to be properly placed. Thread 3 15/0 seed beads and go through the fifth bead. Then go to the fourth. Thread 3 seed beads, go through the third and so on until you have woven 6 groups of 3 seed beads. Return to the center and between the two central rockeries. Pass the thread in a closed iniq then in the rockery opposite, go to the bottom delicas and return to the rockery before to pass a second time through the ring and the rockery opposite. Tie a knot with the thread, wedge it in the beads and cut it.

5. For the light have a small link on which you will not fix a closed ring but pass an open ring between the beads and the pendant once we have cut the thread.

6. Open the ring of the neckband to remove the clasp and pass the closed ring of the small heart pendant then reattach everything.

7. For the other pendant, cut the chain to the desired length and make sure to finish with a long stitch on each side. In the center of the necklace you will have a small link on which you will attach the pendant with the open ring.
