Add a T-shaped maxi clasp to fasten your bracelet in style and you're done... or almost!

Our tip: use one or two nylon-tipped pliers to avoid damaging the chain.

Your bracelet is ready! You can wear it alone or in combination with [a weekly bracelet](#), for example!
