

DIY MIRROR WITH DRIED FLOWERS

Do you want to see yourself as a princess or a forest fairy in the morning? We have the solution! Make your mirror with dried flowers and spring will be with you all day. Well, maybe we're exaggerating a bit too much, but a mirror surrounded by flowers, whatever we say, it's still a very cute quick DIY!

In this tutorial, we offer you different <u>dried flowers</u>, flattened or on stems, but you can choose your favorite flowers adapted to your decoration among more than thirty references of dried flowers on our site. Find in the branches of dried eucalyptus, <u>immortelles from Var</u>, Gypsophila, Nigella flowers and many other decorative dried plants.

The small, flattened flowers are glued to the mirror with a glossy varnish applied underneath and over the flowers. Be careful, however, after drying the hydrangeas and pansies have curled up a little on the edges so you will not have a completely flat result. The varnish also changes their colors a little. For other small dried flowers, no worries! The smaller they are, the less they will tend to deform.

The mirror is glued to cardboard with hot glue. Put a good amount and press on the mirror, sticking it and moving it a little so that the glue is evenly distributed. Extend the cardboard by 5 mm all around the mirror so that you can stick the dried flowers on the stem. Put hot glue at the junction between the mirror and the cardboard to further solidify the fixing of the mirror and quickly glue your dried wheat strand of which you will have previously cut a large part of the stem. Decorate the ears of wheat with other flowers such as natural or colored dried phalaris flowers. Use it to hide the last visible pieces of cardboard.









You can then put your mirror on a dressing table, a chest of drawers or attach small supports at the back to hang it on the wall. Lately, a trend with this type of mirror has emerged on Instagram. The goal was to take a picture of yourself in a flowery mirror.
