

## MEN'S BRACELET MULTIRANKS WOODEN BEADS AND BUDDHA

Discover without further delay this jewelry tutorial to make a multi-row men's bracelet. Fine and in brown and gold tones, it will also suit women and why not make matching couple bracelets? This bracelet has a strong magnetic clasp, wooden beads and frosted tiger eye stone beads. It was believed in the past that tiger's eye had a protective power. It was worn by some warriors in the Roman Empire. This will make you an anecdote to tell when you offer this bracelet!

This DIY men's bracelet is also composed of 2 mm cords and double pushers for golden lace. A pusher with a Buddha representation is placed in the center. You can also make this bracelet without beads, using just two cords. These cords are available in different colours: navy blue, black, grey, etc. The pushers and the clasp are also available in aged silver. We have added the gold and silver version in the material list so that you can choose what suits you best.

This men's bracelet with wooden beads has a zen side, a bit boho chic that will match perfectly with most outfits: whether it's a dressy suit or a streetwear jogging suit!

## Which material to use for Men's bracelet multiranks wooden beads and Buddha?

Tortue Nylon thread Transparent 0.20mm x100m

Polyester cord type snake cord 2 mm brown x2m

## steps

### ★ Step 1/4

Cut 2 cords at the wrist + 2 cm. Glue the first cord in the magnetic clasp.



### ★ Step 2/4

Cut nylon thread 3 times the length of the cord. Double it on the needle and make a double knot at the end. Stitch a few millimetres from the end of the second cord and glue it in the clasp.



### ★ Step 3/4

Wrap the other two ends of the cords with tape. Thread 2 double pushers, 1 Buddha pusher, 2 double pushers. Cut the nylon thread in half and thread the beads. Thread each thread through a different hole in the pusher so that the beads are centred on the bracelet.



★ Step 4/4

Check that the Buddha is well centered on the bracelet otherwise add or remove beads. Thread the 2 threads on the needle and prick a few millimetres from the end of one of the cords. Tie the thread tightly. Cut the cords if necessary and glue them in the clasp. Wait 24 hours before wearing the bracelet.
