Have fun with this tutorial, you will find two pairs of very easy to make earrings with pendants and Plexiglas inserts with a leopard pattern. These trendy jewels have been created for a collection called "the formula of happiness" rings, multi-row bracelet, bracelets with fresh water pearls, necklace with charms. All pearls and finishes have been selected according to the most sought-after jewellery trends of the moment.

These earrings are what we call minute jewellery, which means that in 5 minutes the time to put a few rings in the holes you will have your two pairs of earrings too pretty, the basket below contains everything you need.



# Which material to use for Karine Earrings?

#### **SUPPLIES**

5X0.7mm Open Jump Rings - European-made -fine Gold plated x50

Ref. : ACC-396 Quantity : 1

11x12mm Eye charm - Fine Gold Plated x1

Ref.: BR-438 Quantity: 2



16mm Zamac round textured earstuds to decorate - fine Gold plated x2

Ref.: EAR-302 Quantity: 2



Horn charm ethnic pattern 15x18 mm fine Gold plated x1

Ref. : META-585 Quantity : 2



Open jump rings7x0.7 925 silver gold tone plated x10

Ref. : SL-195 Quantity : 1



19mm Plexiglas sequin leopard pattern - Brown - Beige x1

Ref. : TIQ-486 Quantity : 2



25x19mm Plexiglas Oval pendant leopard pattern - Black - Blue - Grey x1

23x11mm Plexiglas 2-hole Half moon spacer leopard pattern - Brown - Beige x1

### steps



Insert a 7 mm ring in the hole of the blue leopard pendant, before closing it add your moon-shaped charm and then go through the hole in the ring of the ear pin. Close the ring with pliers. Do the same for the second earring.



### ★ Step 2/2

To make this new pair of earrings you have to take 5 mm thinner rings and add one more per earring. Connect your half-round spacer with the round pendant and add an eye shaped charm before closing the ring. Pass another ring to suspend the earring from the earring stud. Do the same for the second ring.
