

DIY CUSTO SPOON WITH SEED BEADS AND CRYSTAL BEADS

Many of you have appreciated the Coral Reef Bracelet tutorial with the magic carpet weaving technique and even more of you have preferred its simplified version. Although it is a technique, or rather a trick totally different from the initial weaving, the result is visually very similar! The magic carpet consists of a base of beads woven in square stitch on which we add lots of loops of seed beads and other beads to give it a rich look. A bit like a carpet with loops. The simplified version uses plastic canvas as a base instead of square stitch beads. This creates a thinner weave and greatly reduces weaving time.

Thanks to this method you will be able to easily customize objects or pouches. The holiday season is a good excuse to start customizing table accessories. This tutorial was created for the magazine ADN plaisir de recevoir on the theme of a fairy tale Christmas. To finish the meal on a poetic touch and dazzle your guests, we suggest you transform a teaspoon!

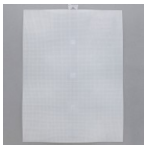
Attention however this customization is not dishwasher safe. If you use the spoon to stir a coffee for example, make the weave shorter so that the coffee doesn't stain the beads and the weave thread.

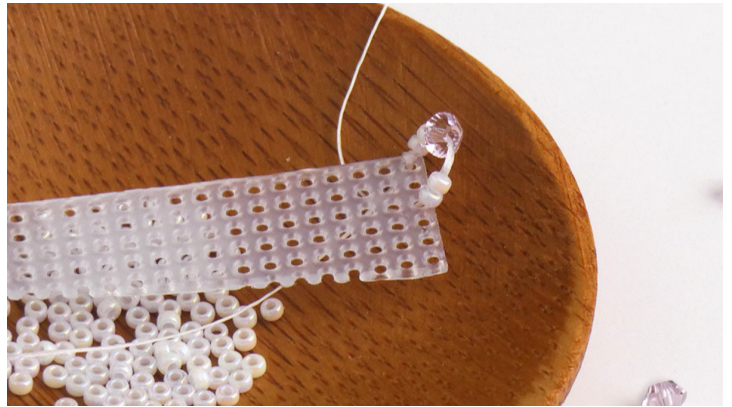
★ Step 1/5

Cut the Plastic Canvas to the size of the surface to be covered on your spoon or other utensil. Try as much as possible not to cut the holes.



★ Step 2/5

Cut 1 m of thread and thread it on a needle and tie the end to one of the corners of your canvas cut. Thread two Miyuki 15/0 rocks, a PureCrystal spinning top, two Miyuki 15/0 rocks and then go through the third hole of the Canvas.



★ Step 3/5

Go back into the second hole from below. Thread five rocks and go into the fourth hole. Then go to the third hole, put on five rocks and go to the fifth hole.



★ Step 4/5

Continue to fill the entire Canvas in this way by adding a different colour top from time to time. You can iron several times in the same place if there is a hole and the plastic is still visible. When the canvas is completely filled and the plastic is no longer visible except on the sides, tie your thread to the back of the canvas.



★ Step 5/5

Stick it on the small spoon and let it dry for 24 hours. Be careful, do not put your creation in the dishwasher, pass it under the tap with cold water if necessary.
