

CHOCKER WITH MIYUKI PEYOTE AND BLUE PEARL CABOCHON

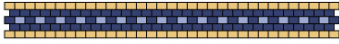

Realize your multi row choker with night blue colours. We have added "pearl" cabochons Miyuki and a pendant imitation gemstone. We have made here an ode weaving with 5 beads. If you are a beginner it would be easier to make an even weaving with 6 beads. Peyote odd weaving pattern:



Peyote even weaving pattern :



Step 1 :
Make the peyote to the size of your neck - 2cm. If you realise an odd use this [technick sheet](#) and if you ake an even peyote weving use, [this one](#).
Make a decreasing [peyote weaving](#) on each side of the choker, add a bead and thread in the bead at the end.



Step 2 :
Add 2 delicats and align the beads side by side. Thread twice in a bead to have a more solid chain. Slip your thread in the external ring of the spacer and wrap this ring with thread. Make at last 2 turns and go out in the last bead you have added . Add 2 more delicats that you aligned as done previously. Do the same on the other side.



Step 3 :
Put a jumpring on each side of the magnetic clasp . Put this clasp in the central ring of the spacer.



Step 4 :
Check the choker and add some jumpring if it's too short.
Fix the Miyuki "pearl" Cabochon on the spacer with glue like "Hasulith". Cut 2 pieces of thread to the desired dimension and add +2cm, so here 17cm. Slip 1 or 2 crimp beads on your thread, slip it into the ring of the spacer and slip it back to block it in the crimp beads that you pull with a plier . You can add some crimp cover for a better finish . Do the same on the other side of the spacer then connect it to the 3 rings spacer with the same technick. Don't forget to slip the crimp beads first before you slip the thread in the ring and back in the crimp beads.



Step 5 :
Cut a piece of thread 40 cm. Adjust it to the desired length and dangle a pendant . Fix it like you have fixed the previous row with crimp beads.

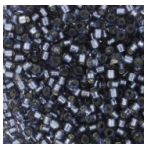

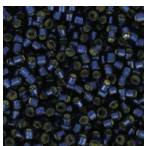

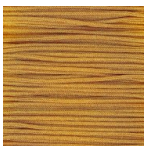
