

This is a very simple chocker, easy to wear every day. It is composed of two herrinbones in peyote weaving and a pendant $\underline{imitation\ gemstone}$

Step 1:

Realise the weaving below twice. You will find the instructions to relaize an <u>odd peyote weavind here</u> and <u>increasing and decreasing here</u>.



Step 2:

Cut the ball chain so that you keep only 1 ball and a piece of chain on each side. Fix this piecec of chain to the petote with some threas and a needle. Do the same on the other side. Connect the other side to a jumpring after you have dangled the pendant.

On the other side or the weaving you fix the chain with thread and a needle. You connect 4 pieces of chain 2 x 2 that you connect to a jumpring.



Step 3 : Cut the ball chain to the desired length , add a claps and the closure ring .
