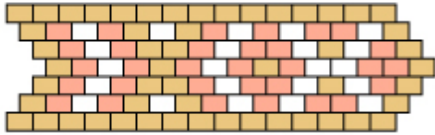

This is a very simple choker , easy to wear every day . It is composed of two herrinbones in peyote weaving and a pendant imitation gemstone

Step 1 :

Realise the weaving below twice. You will find the instructions to relaize an odd peyote weavind here and increasing and decreasing here.



Step 2 :

Cut the ball chain so that you keep only 1 ball and a piece of chain on each side. Fix this piecec of chain to the petote with some threas and a needle . Do the same on the other side. Connect the other side to a jumpring after you have dangled the pendant.

On the other side or the weaving you fix the chain with thread and a needle . You connect 4 pieces of chain 2 x 2 that you connect to a jumpring. .



Step 3 :

Cut the ball chain to the desired length , add a claps and the closure ring .

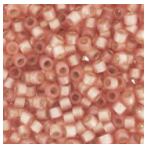
