This bracelet tutorial is very easy to make. It is important to read our technical sheet to learn how to make a <u>simple sliding</u> knot. Thanks to this knot, you will be able to adjust the size of your bracelet.

Which material to use for Sliding bracelet with gold-plated star charm?

SUPPLIES

10mm Atelier Brunette Viscose fabric bias - Seed Chestnut x1m

Ref. : CRD-310 Quantity : 1

6mm Worked Cube Bead - 3 micron Gold plated x1

Ref.: PLO-042 Quantity: 2

5x0.8mm Open Jump Rings - 3 micron Gold Plated x4

Ref. : PLO-068 Quantity : 1

14x12.5mm Star pendant - 3 micron gold plated x1

Ref. : PLO-070 Quantity : 1





steps



★ Step 1/2

Iron your bias to mark the fold and flatten it well. Insert the gold-plated tubes in the bias. To make it easier for you, it is recommended to put a small piece of tape at the end of the bias, it will be easier for you to put the bead on the ribbon.



Step 2/2

Make the sliding knot with the help of our technical sheet. Make a loop with the bias, then wrap the bias around the bias and pass it through the loop.

Do the same for the second slip knot. Add the star charm in the middle and your fabric bracelet is finished.
