How to make a bracelet with small beads?

How to make a bracelet with small colored beads?

This month, we have chosen the Pastel theme for our "Fleurs de Pastel" jewellery collection: a collection of jewellery with soft and delicate colours.

In this tutorial we explain how to make a women's bracelet with coloured beads. These triangle shaped metal beads fit perfectly together. Just mix them with small seed beads and colored rectangle beads to get this pretty DIY bracelet.

You can also integrate beads letters 2 holes to make a bracelet with a message so trendy today: a first name, a word, you choose something that looks like you. Our creator Tiffanie made a letter bracelet with these 2 holes beads, do not hesitate to go and have a look at her creation.

This tutorial is perfect if you are new to creating costume jewelry DIY. Just thread the beads in the right order and follow some steps to make your elastic bracelet, including pre-stretching your thread. We've listed the 6 reasons why your bracelet may break or deform.

★ Step 1/3

Thread the beads following the model in the photo.
Close your elastic bracelet with 2 surgeon's knots. Follow the explanations in the video to make your knot correctly.



★ Step 2/3

String the beads as shown in the photo.

★ Step 3/3

Close your elastic bracelet with 2 surgeon's knots. Follow the instructions in our video to tie your surgeon's knot correctly.
