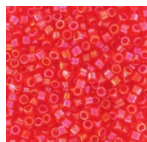
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How to weave a vintage car with brickstitch?

★ Step 1/2

This weaving is made with the brickstitch technique.

If you are a beginner in bead weaving, we advise you to have a look at our technical sheets:

- How to start a brick stitch weaving
 - How to make decreases and increases with the brickstitch technique
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★ Step 2/2

Start your weaving with the longest line of the diagram, the one just above the wheels. Weave your diagram following the color indications of the diagram provided by Coeur Citron.

Once your weaving is finished, you can use it as a brooch, bookmark, refrigerator magnet... You just have to stiffen the weaving with a glue varnish and let it dry before fixing it to its support.

Result
