

How to weave seasonal fruits and vegetables into Miyuki beads?

You may have already seen them at the edge of the woods and paths, blackberries and mushrooms are out!For this occasion, and to continue the nice series of fridge magnets that Léa aka @3princessesàlamaison has in store for us, she's back today with two treasures of the woods: a blackberry and a mushroom in relief. n Here's a good way to combine business with pleasure: weave a pretty pattern to leave on the fridge to remind us which fruits and vegetables are in season to put in our baskets and our recipes. In this tutorial, you will find diagrams and steps to weave a blackberry and a mushroom and mount them in magnet. The weaving is done with the brick stitch technique, for which you will find our advice by consulting these two technical sheets:




★ Step 1/6

Weave the 3 elements of the mulberry independently following the pattern.



★ Step 2/6

Fix the three elements with jewellery glue.



★ Step 3/6

On the back, attach the magnet with jewellery glue.





★ Step 4/6

Weave the 3 elements of the mushroom independently following the pattern.



★ Step 5/6

Fix the three elements with jewellery glue.



★ Step 6/6

On the back, attach the magnet with jewellery glue.
