

## HANDY WOOL CUSHION DMC

Do you know the arm knitting ? This is the art of knitting with arms! DMC offers a wool made of tubular yarn, light and soft to the touch, named **Alize** which allows to knit easily without needles.

Aline blog **Alize in the country of the mas**, we propose to make a cushion with this new wool and the result is so nice that we want to redecorate his living room or his room by making several cushions of all colors!

A big thank you to Aline for teaching us the technique of arm knitting.

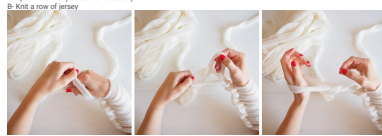


How to make knitting without a needle?  
Here are the technical tips for learning knitting without needles and mastering the knitting technique.



The first step is to leave a piece of wool, called wire A, long enough to mount your mesh. For this project you will need about 2 meters of wool (50 cm of which will be used for sewing on the right side).

- Following this length, make a slipknot and loop the resulting loop around your right wrist.
- Hold the two wires firmly in your left palm, slide your thumb and forefinger in the center of its threads from the inside to the outside and fit your wrist back. The placement of the threads is important, the thread A must be around the thumb and the thread coming from the ball on the index finger.
- A loop under the thumb is thus formed. Pass your right hand from bottom to top through this loop, grab the thread on the index finger and bring it back through the loop. This is your first stitch, place it on your right hand. Be careful not to over-tighten your work!
- Repeat "A" as many times as necessary.



With the stitches on the right arm :

- Using your right hand hold the yarn from the ball in your palm, slide the first loop on your arm and bring the thread back through this loop. And here you are, knitting your first stitch. Place there on your left arm. Repeat until the end of the row.

With the stitches on the left arm :

- With your left hand hold the yarn from the ball in your palm, slide the first loop on your arm and bring the thread back through this loop. And here you knit your first stitch. Place there on your right arm. Repeat until the end of the row.

Cast off the stitches

Knit two stitches in place

- Step 1: Slip the first knitted stitch over the second and let it fall out of your arm. You have just folded a stitch!
- Step 2: There is one stitch on your arm, knit a new stitch and repeat step 1.
- Repeat steps 2 and 1 until there is only one stitch remaining and stop the work by passing the thread through the loop of the last stitch and pulling.



The seams of the sides of the cover are 1 mesh from the edge, it is also called edge mesh, it is easily recognizable because it forms a small V. At this stage the knit should be placed upside down, with the place in front of you.

- To assemble two sides simply pass the thread on either side of the knitting, from right to left then from left to right, stitching in each small hole at the base of each edge stitch. Once sewing done it is recommended to make a pass in reverse on a few stitches before cutting the thread.



E: Tip of the designer

At the end of the knit and once the stitches are folded, it is helpful to leave enough thread length to sew the bottom and left sides of the cushion. The right side when to him, will be sewn with the wire (A) mounting.

To hide and secure sewing threads, simply cut the wool as close as possible to the knit and secure the thread with a few stitches, by hand, on the underside of the knit.



Realization of the cushion cover

STEP 1

FR 12 inches.

Knit 21 rows stockinette at then bind off all sts. This gives you a rectangle with a dimension of 80 x 40 cm.

STEP 2

Place your cushion inside your knit, fold it in two upside down, finally close your cover by making the seams on all three sides.

Your cushion is finished. Thanks to this blanket wool, you will be able to easily bring a touch of softness and a cozy atmosphere to your interior. Ideal for the transition to autumn / winter.
