How to make vintage 80's style earrings?

In this jewellery tutorial, we decided to gather 3 easy earrings assemblies with coloured resin beads. Some of these earrings already exist in tutorial, but in other colors or with some different beads. In particular the resin drop earrings made by Lucie T. All these beads are available in different colors, so don't hesitate to have a look in our vintage resin beads category.

If these 3 earrings have been gathered in the same tutorial, it's because they are coordinated. Fuchsia is the trendy color of the fall winter 2021/2022. This color goes very well with plum. We wanted to show you some beads in these shades for inspiration. The second reason is that we regularly post mini DIY videos on our instagram account and you want to easily find the materials used. Your wish is granted!

All the materials are listed at the bottom of the page. You will see that some products are found in 2 different pairs of earrings. For example, the flat head studs are used in two projects as well as the gold beads and the gold washers. So there is a little less material to buy to make all 3. If you have flashed on one of the 3 pairs, you can take advantage of it to make 2 small gifts to friends for the other two pairs.

steps

★ Step 1/3

Thread the following beads on a flat head nail: 1 golden round 5 mm, 1 dark grey striped tube bead, 1 round 12 mm fuchsia. Bend the nail at 90° over the hole in the bead. Cut the stem at 1 cm from the hole then, with a round pliers, form a loop in the opposite direction and before closing the loop, slip the nail into the ring of the ear stud. Close the loop. There should not be any space left where the earring could go. Go to this page to see the gesture in video: [To form a loop on a stud or a stem for jewels.](#)



★ Step 2/3

The method is the same as before. This time, thread on the nail: 1 fuchsia drop, 1 golden roundel, 1 diamond bead, and 1 golden bead 5 mm.



★ Step 3/3

Start by threading a stopper bead onto the creole and slide it onto the other side. String 3 x 4mm beads, 1 x small gold washer, 1 x 6mm bead, 1 x small gold washer, 1 x 6mm bead, 1 x large gold washer and repeat in reverse order to have the same on both sides of the creole. Carefully move the stopper beads to center the beads.
