

MULTIRANGS PURECRYSTAL CHAIN WITH SERPENTINE CHAIN

In this tutorial we will learn how to make a multi-row bracelet with <u>serpentine chain</u> and <u>PureCrystal tops</u>. Simple, chic and elegant, this multi-row bracelet will accompany both your evening wear and your everyday clothes



Important. In this tutorial we will use the serpentine chain 0.8mm and PureCrystal bicones 3 mm and 4 mm. Be careful: The chain just goes back into the tops. You will have to demonstrate dexterity and precision and force their passage. If you prefer, you can use 0.6 mm gold filled serpentine chain with 1.3 mm crimp beads to lock the beads in the desired location.
Step 1:
Out the chain into 8 pieces of exactly 12.5 cm.



2nd step:
Put a tiny bit of glue on the end of one of the chains, pass a <u>bead to crush 2 mm</u> and flatten it just right on the end of the chain, without letting it pass on the other side.
Repeat this step for all chain pieces. Be sure to do this only on one side of the chain.



Step 3: Fold down one of the tabs on the weave end and flatten the end of the end slightly to reduce the size of the slot. Slip the ends of the chain with the bead crushed one by one in the mouthpiece and close it. Warning ! Wait until the glue is dry before sliding them!



Step 4:

Slip the PureCrystal tops on each piece. Fold the end of the chain to the point using a flat pliers to facilitate the passage. If the 3mm rotors really do not pass, even forcing, first put a 4mm router and try again with another 3mm router.

The advantage of using the 0.8 mm serpentine chain is that crushing pears can be dispensed with to keep the rotors in place because some rotors with a slightly smaller hole will fix the others. If placing crimp beads does not bother you, use the 6mm gold filled serpentine chain. Remember to put the pears to crush at the same time as the tops.

Once PureCrystal spinning tops put on the chain, put a tip of glue and flaten a bead to crush on the end to close it.

Do the same for all the chains then add them in the second wearing end and close the tongue.



Step 5: Add the extension chain and clasp with rings
