How to make a beaded ball?

Here is a tutorial for our bead weaving and beading experts. Beaded balls are a very pretty technique that can be easily done by simply changing the beads. However, they can become a real headache for those who are not used to complex patterns. This tutorial is a little nod to the origin of Perles And Co. Indeed, the website Perles and Co was created in 2004 and offered crystal beads and primers to create your jewelry. Do you remember those crystal spinning top rings?

Here is a beads tutorial worthy of the 2000s, but modernized with beads and trendy colors. The tiny 2mm round PureCrystal beads will allow you to create small beaded balls with the perfect size to make light pendant earrings or a small pendant.

You can also try to recreate this ball with seed beads or gemstone beads. Let your imagination run wild.

Here the balls are threaded onto dangling earrings before being closed completely. These ear chains can be strung doubled or you can put a stopper bead at the end of the stem.

Be careful to use fireline wire as shown and not soft weaving wire like Miyuki wire because the beads may cut the wire.
