### *How to make vintage earrings?*

Spring is finally here, to celebrate this change with you, we suggest you make a pair of earrings both vintage and original by these colors. A perfect jewel that follows the trend of pastel colors and reminds the 70s. These earrings would go perfectly on a little flowery dress or a simple blouse. À You can match them according to your desires. As for the technique, nothing too complicated, you just need to form a loop with the brass wire to close the jewel. To help you make this loop, take a look at our technical sheet: [How to form a loop on a stud or a jewelry pin?](#) For this pair of earrings you will assemble round beads of different sizes and colors with spinners, wire and an ear stud all in silver and pastel.

As for personalization, this jewel can be created in many different colors from [round resin beads](#) The hardest part will be to choose among all the references. If you are a fan of gilding, swap the silver with this gold ear stud. ## steps

### ★ Step 1/5

Choose your different sizes and colors of round resin beads and spinning tops.



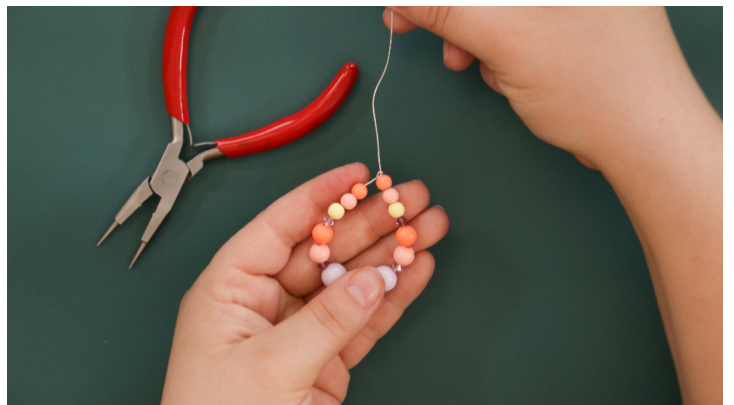
### ★ Step 2/5

Thread on the wire in this order: 1 coral bead 6mm, 1 pink bead 6mm, 1 yellow bead 6mm, a spinning top, 1 coral bead 8mm, 1 pink bead 8mm, a spinning top, 1 purple bead 10mm, 1 yellow bead 10mm.  
Do the same step to make the symmetry.



### ★ Step 3/5

Make a loop on one end. Pass the other end through the loop and then through the ear stud. Pull until the beads are tight.



★ Step 4/5

Cut off the excess yarn. You should have enough wire left to close the whole thing with a loop.  
Do the same steps for the second earring. And that's it!



★ Step 5/5

Do the same steps for the second earring. And that's it!
