

WEAVING MIYUKI BRICK STITCH WOVEN WORDS ON EMBROIDERY DRUM

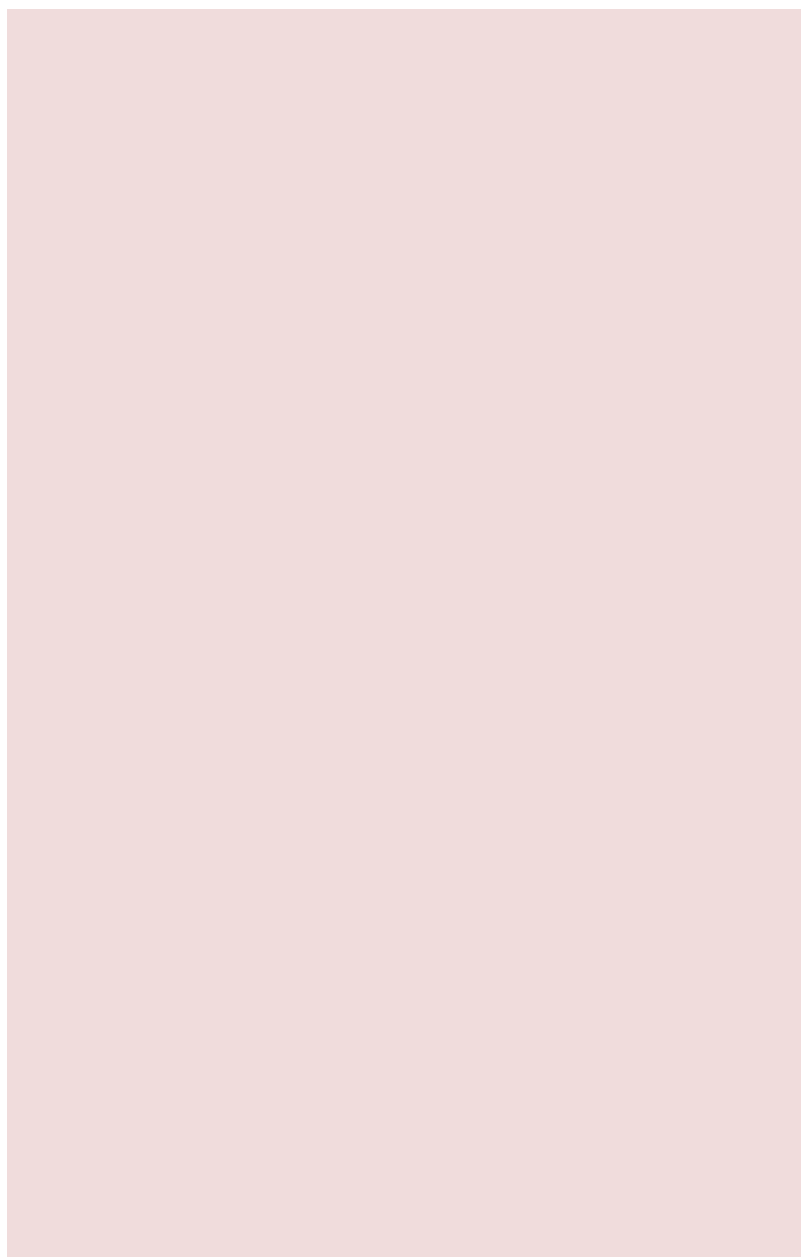
Do you like [Miyuki pearls](#) and want to further customize your bracelets by inserting words or phrases? - It's now possible with Karyn from the blog [Mamoizelle K](#). She has put together an alphabet to write your words according to the technique of brick stitch .

For beginners, do not hesitate to consult our [data sheets](#) to learn how to weave pearls: it's easier than it sounds ! After that, you will not have to apprehend [weaving in brick stitch with increase and reduction](#) .

We thank Karyn for telling us step by step how to make Miyuki beaded letters and have shared these two diagrams.

Step 1

To begin, take a thread of about 1 meter and thread two needles at each end (you will mount your first row according to the technique of the ladder). Then place a bead on the wire. Pass the second bead in both hands crossing them. You will see that the pearl is positioned on the first: it's a good sign, keep going!

For an increase at the beginning of the row, you must put the first two beads (one golden and one black) and come pass the needle under the loop formed by the last two pearls of the previous rank. Gently pull on the thread and iron the needle into the black bead (on the side where the needle came out).

You will see that the pearls are positioned. It's perfect ! Continue pearl after pearl and you will soon see the result ...

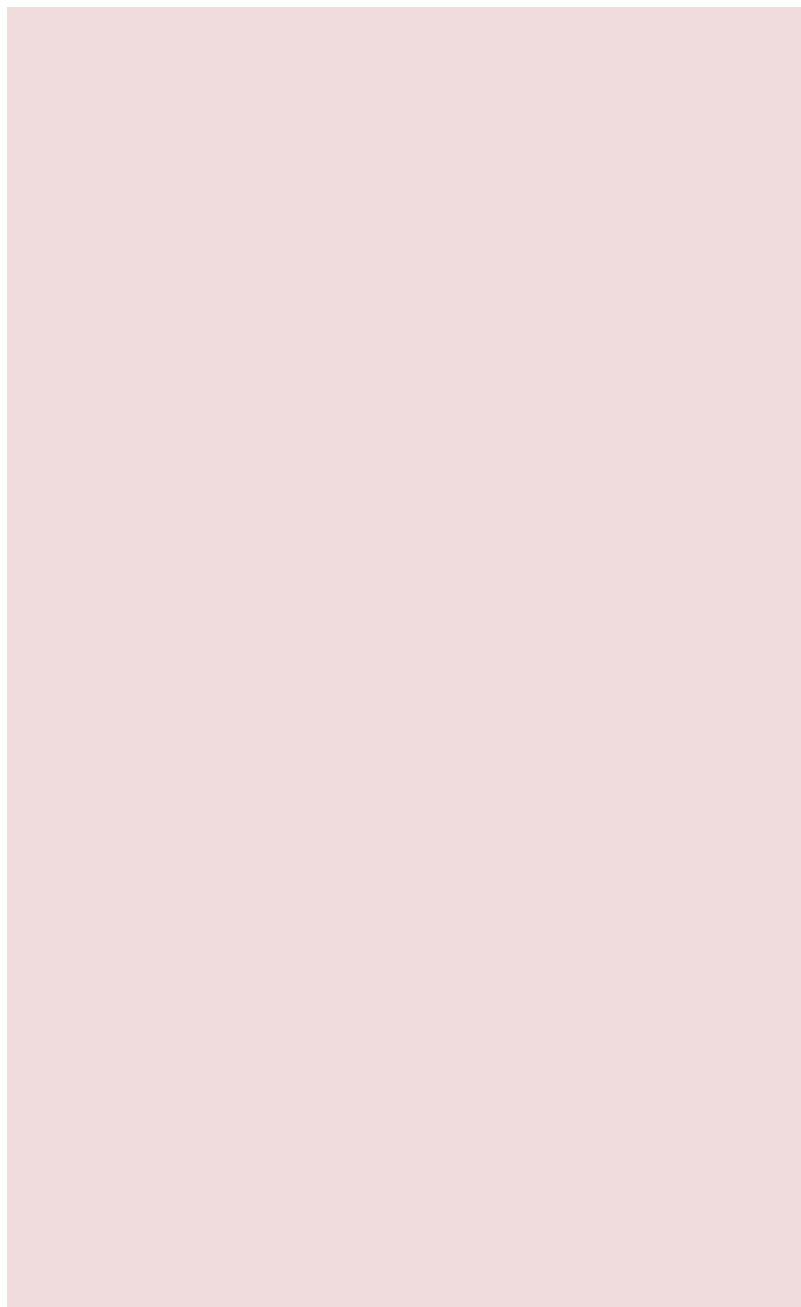
2nd step

For the end of rank increase, take a bead, put it on and pass the needle under the loop created by the last bead threaded and that of the previous row. Weave thus row by row. Once the weaving is done, do not forget to get in the threads by making them secure.

Step 3

If you want, like Karyn, to present in an original and cute way your woven words, you must bring 3 embroidery drums. Stretch the linen on the drum and screw. You just have to cut the surplus in the back and sew your words and patterns!

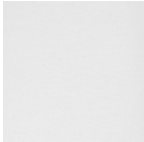
