How to make earrings with large links?

This DIY will allow you to create trendy earrings in less than 5 minutes. These are large resin links that are very easy to assemble. By sliding the links inside a pair of stainless steel hoop earrings, you can easily transform them into earrings. Then, no need to buy new earrings. If you want to change the color of the links, just put the earrings on another set. So you will have the possibility to have several colors of vintage earrings to change according to your outfits. To add a little touch of originality, we added sequined pendants at the bottom of each earring. Feel free to personalize yours.

The big link jewelry trend has made a comeback in the fashion world recently. Reminiscent of the 80s and 90s, this trend features necklaces, bracelets and earrings with thick, imposing links, often made of colorful plastic. Contrary to what you might think, large plastic links have the advantage of being light, which makes them comfortable to wear all day. Plus, they offer a wide variety of colors. Kit of 3 Pliers professional quality for jewelry - Chain nose pliers, Cutting pliers, Round nose pliers

steps

★ Step 1/2

Slide the small link into the large link, matching the slots of the two links. Open a 10 mm ring with two jewelry pliers. Rotate the two ends of the ring instead of pulling them apart. This will prevent the ring from becoming distorted.

★ Step 2/2

Place the ring at the bottom of the large link. Before closing it, slip the pendant into it. You will have removed the ring that came with the pendant before. Swing the two ends of the 10mm ring together. Put glue, clear nail polish or UV LED resin on the opening of the ring to prevent it from opening.
Now all you have to do is open the creoles and slide them into the little links!
