How to make a ring with natural stones?

Fall for the natural stone trend with this oval ring tutorial! Simple to make and inexpensive, you'll be able to do it even if you're a beginner in jewelry design.

For this tutorial, I've chosen to use amazonite beads for both the cabochon and the beads around the ring. However, you can choose to use other beads if you wish. Why not imagine a little mix of colors for the more creative among you? The cabochon compatible with the ring is available in several stone categories: Carnelian, Howlite, Amethyst, Lapis Lazuli or Moonstone. As for the 2mm pearls all around the ring, we have a wide choice on our website, so you're sure to find what you're looking for!

The little extra of this ring? It's adjustable and fits sizes 52 to 58. Ideal if you'd like to offer a piece of handmade jewelry to a loved one and don't know their finger size.

Which material to use for Oval ring with cabochon and natural stones?

304L stainless steel Adjustable ring with 4 rings for 6x4mm cabochon - Gold x1

Ref. : ACX-971 Quantity : 1



Jewel Glue Hasulith 30ml

6x4mm Flat oval cabochon - palet - gemstone - Amazonite x1

Bead Faceted round beads 2mm Amazonite x38cm

0.15mm Supplemax Monofilament illusion cord - Transparent x50 m

steps

★ Step 1/3

To begin, we'll glue our cabochon to the ring support using Hasulith glue. Place a dot of glue in the center of the ring and glue your cabochon. Allow to dry for 24 hours before continuing with your creation. You can also choose to do this step last if you wish.



★ Step 2/3

Next, take your nylon thread and cut a sufficient length. Start by tying a double knot on the first ring. If you're just starting out, take a look at this <u>earrings</u> <u>tutorial</u>, which will show you how to tie the knots. The wire used is different, but the technique remains the same.

Next, start stringing your natural stone beads. Use a needle to make threading easier.



★ Step 3/3

Go all the way around, threading the needle through each ring as you go.
