How to make a bracelet from tube beads?

Discover in this tutorial how to make elastic bracelets with curved tube beads. We've used curved tube beads in different colors: blue, pink, white and curved glitter beads in multicolor, silver and gold. These beads come in two sizes: 32x8 mm and 35x11 mm. For this tutorial, we've used the 32x8mm beads, but you can find other beads in product variations. Get inspired by our other tutorials for creating bracelets with tube beads: elastic bracelets with green and purple tube beads and bracelets with gold, white and neon pink accumulation.

For this tutorial, to contrast the colorful tube beads, we've added rhinestone rondelle beads to match the curved tube beads in size 32x8mm and brushed-effect Heishi rondelle beads to match the curved tube beads in size 35x11mm. Bracelets are suitable for wrists up to 19 cm. If your wrist is longer than 19 cm, plan to buy a few more tube beads and cut more wire.

These bracelets don't require a clasp, just a <u>double surgeon's knot</u> to close them with the elastic thread. To make long-lasting elastic bracelets, please follow the steps below, which are also detailed in the following photos:

1

Cut 35 cm of elastic thread.

2.

Stretch your wire to force it to relax. Elastic thread always relaxes a little at first. If you stretch it before making the bracelet, it won't stretch at all or much less once you're wearing it.

3.

String your beads.

4.

Tie a double surgeon's knot.

5

Tighten the wire. Also tighten from the inside of the bracelet.

6

Cut the wires to within 2 mm of the knot.

7

Put glue on the knot and slide the knot inside a bead to hide it.

Which material to use for Colored tube bracelets?

Elastic Cord 0.70 mm Jewellery Elastic Cord - Transparent x 25 m

10x0.8mm Heishi rondelle beads brushed effect - Gold Tone x5g approx 9pcs

steps



★ Step 1/3

Cut about 35 cm of elastic thread and pull slightly to loosen. Start stringing tube beads interspersed with Heishi washers.

For this bracelet, we did it as follows:

- one multicolored spotted tube bead
- one pink tube bead
- 4 Heishi beads
- one blue tube bead
- one multicolored spotted tube bead
- 4 Heishi beads
- one pink tube bead



★ Step 2/3

Once you've inserted all your tube beads and washers, you can tie a double surgeon's knot to close your bracelet.

★ Step 3/3

Repeat the same steps to make the second bracelet.



Result
