How to make an ultra-simple Miyuki bracelet?

These little easy beaded bracelets are a must-have accessory for your wardrobe. They're simple to make, simple to put on and simple to give away. In fact, thanks to the adjustable fastening system, you don't need to know the wrist size of the person you want to give it to. Its sliding clasp bead, more commonly known as the stopper bead, allows you to adjust the size of the bracelet and open and close it without assistance. You can customize your bracelet by choosing from dozens of colors of <u>braided nylon thread; 0.5 mm</u> and more than 1000 references of <u>Miyuki Delica 11/0 beads</u>. The stopper bead can be replaced by a <u>macramatic sliding knot</u> or a <u>flowing capuchin knot</u>. However, using a stopper bead as a clasp has many advantages:

- The finish is stronger compared to a sliding knot
- · The bracelet is easier to make
- · The bracelet is faster to make
- The result looks better

If you want to make lots of bracelets, stopper beads in gold filled or laminated gold may seem like a reasonable budget. But if you buy them in packs of 5 (i.e. 10 pearls), you'll pay a reduced price. That's why we've decided on a tutorial with 10 bracelets. What's more, you only need a hundred or fewer beads per bracelet. Each 8g bag contains around 1400. So you can choose fewer colors if you want to keep your shopping cart low. Finally, the wire is sold in 10-meter lengths. For an adult bracelet, you'll need to cut between 30 and 35 cm of wire. So you can make more than 30 bracelets with a single color of wire.

These bracelets are perfect for making lots of little end-of-year gifts, for example.

★ Step 1/4

For a child's bracelet or a very thin adult bracelet, cut 25 cm of wire. For a larger bracelet, cut between 30 and 35 cm of thread. Thread the thread onto a reformable needle eye. Thread the stopper bead and place it near the end of the thread. Thread a craser bead.



Step 2/4

- 100% gold bracelet: Thread 10 cm of gold beads for a small wrist and 12 à 14 cm for a larger wrist.
- · Bracelet 3 couleurs alternées : String 3 pearls of a color A, 1 golden pearl, 3 pearls of a color B, 1 golden pearl, 3 pearls of a color C, 1 golden pearl. Then repeat this sequence 5 times for a small bracelet and more for a large one. Finish with 3 beads in color A.
- · Bracelet with charm: String 10 beads of one color A, 3 gold, 1 bead of color B, 3 gold, (repeat this sequence once more for a wider bracelet) 10 beads of one color A, 3 gold, 1 bead of color B, 3 gold, 3 beads of one color A, 1 gold, 1 bead of color B. Open a ring, slide in the charm, close the ring and slip it on. Répétez l'enchaînement de perles dans le sens inverse.
- · Bracelet with all colors: String 7 red beads, 1 gold bead, 3 lilac beads, 1 gold bead, 1 turquoise bead, 1 gold bead, 1 turquoise bead, 1 gold bead, 1 turquoise bead, 1 gold bead, 7 pink beads, 1 gold bead, 3 dark green beads, 7 gold beads, 1 red bead, 1 gold bead, 1 red bead. Repeat in reverse order. Adjust the number of beads for a larger bracelet.



Step 3/4

&At the end of each bracelet, thread a bead écraser. Center the beads on the wire and crush the beads on each side to hold them in place.



Step 4/4

Pinch the threads at the stopper bead to free up space in the bead hole for the needle. Thread a stopper bead onto each end of thread and flatten. Break off the thread ends or recut them close to the beads.
