Composed of 4 mm pearly beads, lilac-tinted quartz beads and adorned with delicate moon and sun charms, these jewels are the perfect finishing touch to sublimate your evening outfits. These anklets are mounted on gold-plated stainless steel primers, guaranteeing an elegant, long-lasting finish. The lilac quartz beads add a touch of color that perfectly complements our model's satin dress. These natural stone beads are available in a wide range of colors. So you can match your bracelets to your own evening wear and pair of pumps. If you're looking to accessorize your party outfits with a hint of originality, an anklet is a great option. Often associated with casual or summer styles, this piece of jewelry is now making its way into chic evenings. Whether it's for a cocktail party, a gala evening, or a family gathering, these anklets will add little originality to your outfits.

One of the benefits of this tutorial is that you can customize the anklets to suit your tastes. Prefer a classic, timeless look? Opt for pearly pearls only. 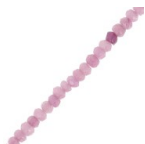

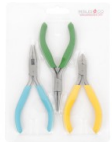

steps

★ Step 1/3

Cut a piece of wire 1? times the size of your ankle. Thread 1 crush bead, the clasp with closed ring and iron through the bead. Allow the piece of wire to protrude by 2 cm.

Flatten the bead, if possible with special crush bead pliers, and fold the bead in half. Check that the wire no longer slips. Fold a crushable pearl cover over the pearl. Close the pearl cover with flat-nose pliers, taking your time to keep the shape round.



★ Step 2/3

String your beads according to your preferences. The thread is slipped into the first beads. No need to cut it. Here, the sequence of beads is: 13 pearly beads 4 mm, 1 clover bead, 6 tinted quartz beads, 13 pearly beads, 3 quartz beads, 1 sun charm mounted on an open ring, 3 quartz beads, 13 pearly beads, 3 quartz beads, 1 gemstone heart charm, 3 quartz beads. Finally, thread a crush pearl and a closed ring, then repeat step 1 to complete the bracelet. Slide 2 cm of double wire through the beads and cut.

Of course, adapt the stringing of beads to the size of your ankle.



★ Step 3/3

For this second version, I've strung 7 pearly beads, 1 quartz bead, 7 pearly beads, 1 quartz bead, 7 pearly beads, 3 quartz beads, 1 rhinestone moon charm that you will have mounted on an open ring, 3 quartz beads, 7 pearly beads, 1 quartz bead, 7 pearly beads, 3 quartz beads, 1 sun charm mounted on a ring, 3 quartz beads, 7 pearly beads, 1 quartz bead. Adapt the sequence to your size.

Repeat step 1 to complete the bracelet. Slip the end of the double thread into the beads over a length of 2 cm.
