How to make a personalized charms necklace?

This tutorial shows you how to create a charms necklace in stainless steel, an oxidation-resistant material. Learn how to create a personalized piece of jewelry, perfect for your winter outfits. The <u>stainless steel charms</u> selected for this necklace are inspired by the cosy, warm atmosphere of the season. <u>Snowflake charms</u>, Christmas sweater charms, quilted heart pendants and other heart-warming goodies, including the adorable sausage dog charm! Sorry, I meant the <u>Dachshund charm</u>!

Stainless steel is a smart choice for designing long-lasting DIY jewelry. It's hypoallergenic and resistant to oxidation. You'll be able to keep your necklace through the seasons by personalizing it very easily: get your jewelry pliers to remove a charm and replace it with your new favorite in less than a minute. It's a necklace you can personalize over and over again, and euros well invested! This tutorial will introduce you to the basics of creating charm necklaces. To make it, you'll need two jewelry pliers: one with flat tips and one with round tips. With these pliers, you'll be able to open and close the junction rings easily to hang your charms around your neck. In fact, the chain is already mounted as a necklace!

The charm necklace is an ideal accessory for winter sweaters or oversized cardigans. By playing with the length of the chain and the arrangement of the charms, you can create a piece of jewelry that perfectly complements a cosy outfit or adds an elegant note to a flowing blouse. This jewel will quickly become the centerpiece of your winter collection, a must-have accessory to accompany your looks while adding a touch of magic and sparkle to your day. Give it as a gift or wear it proudly, this charms necklace is a creation that won't go unnoticed.

steps

★ Step 1/3


Place your choker on the table and arrange your charms. Locate the center link of the necklace by folding it in half. On this link, you'll place the largest pendant, in this case the quilted heart. Separate the charms by one link. Place the larger pendants and charms preferably towards the center of the necklace, but put smaller charms between the larger charms so they overlap less when worn.



★ Step 2/3

To make this **personalized necklace with charms**, all you need are two jewelry pliers and the ability to <u>open and</u> <u>close connecting rings</u>. Click on the link to watch a video showing how to do it.

Hold the ring with a pair of pliers in each hand and rotate one plier towards you and the other in the opposite direction, without pulling the ends apart.



★ Step 3/3

Hold the ring with one clamp in your hand. With your other hand, slide one link of the chain into the ring, then your charm. To close the ring, realign the ends in the opposite direction, until they touch perfectly. You can go back and forth a little to make them fit perfectly.
