Which material to use for Seed beads and freshwater pearls red bracelet?

2mm Crimp beads - Gold x 200
Ref. : APT-069

7x6mm Irregular baroque freshwater pearls - Grade AA White x10
Ref. : FW-116

Clasp T for bracelet or necklace 14 mm Stainless steel 304L Gold x1
Ref. : INX-243

4x0.9mm 304 Stainless Steel Heishi Disc Beads - Flat Disc - Gold Tone x10

4 mm knot covers with closed rings - 304L Stainless Steel Gold x4

4x0.7mm 316L Stainless Steel Open jumpRings - Gold Tone x10

4mm Seed beads 6/0 - Mix Red x20g

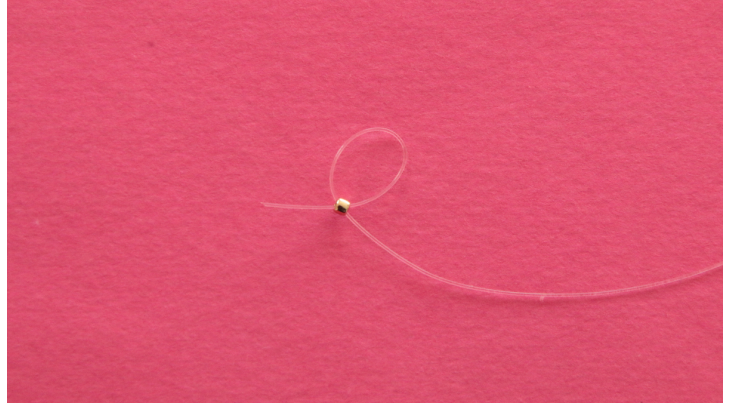


Tortue Nylon thread Transparent 0.35mm x100m

steps

★ Step 1/6

For the bracelet, start by cutting your thread, here I cut 25cm for a wrist circumference of cm. Then, thread a Crimp bead and iron the thread through the bead in the same direction.



★ Step 2/6

You can now flatten the bead with flat-nose pliers. Next, thread the knot cover through the hole with the two wire ends. Then close the knot cover, taking care not to flatten it.

★ Step 3/6

You can start creating your bracelet by adding 3 Seed beads 6/0, a Heishi bead, again 3 Seed beads 6/0 and a freshwater pearl. You can repeat this step 2 times.



★ Step 4/6

To create a little fantasy, add two more freshwater beads. You can repeat step 3.



★ Step 5/6

To complete the bracelet, you'll need two rings, which you'll add to your bow covers and your two clasp ends.



★ Step 6/6

And now your beautiful creation is ready!
