How to make a bracelet with a buoy clasp?

This <u>beaded bracelet</u> is a great jewelry idea to create for summer. Easy to make in just 15 minutes, it combines blue and white <u>ceramic beads</u> with starfish and imitation freshwater pearls, creating a fresh, light look that's perfect for the season. Starfish are really in vogue this summer, so don't hesitate to add them to your summer creations! It's the marine pattern you'll see everywhere! The trend is also for beads to be strung randomly, creating a more natural look. That's what I did for this bracelet, while respecting a certain logic: I put small beads near the clasp, rather than large ones, so I could attach it more easily. I also distributed the touches of gold evenly. The clasp, in gold-plated stainless steel, is practical and durable. This metal doesn't oxidize, making it the ideal choice for accessories worn during the summer months, especially to avoid the risk of corrosion from sweat. Just remember to remove it before swimming to preserve the brilliance of the beads.

This bracelet is super-easy to personalize and will add an original touch to your summer outfits. It goes very well with light clothing like a white dress or linen top. Imagine it worn with a flowing summer dress, sandals and a straw hat: a simple yet chic look. It also goes perfectly with more casual outfits, like cotton jeans or denim shorts. This marine-themed bead bracelet pairs well with soft hues like white, beige or pastel blue, but also stands out against brighter colors like coral or turquoise.

Not only is this jewel perfect for complementing your summer outfits, it's also a great idea for a handmade gift. Easy to make, it offers a personal and original touch that's sure to please. steps

★ Step 1/1

Cut 30 cm of wire. Thread a Crimp bead. Thread the wire through the wire guard. Thread the clasp ring over the wire and wire guard. Pass the wire end through the Crimp bead. Allow it to protrude by 2 cm. Flatten the bead with flat-nose pliers or special bead-crushing pliers. Put a bead cover on top if you wish. Be careful, the metal is very hard, so they are difficult to close.
