This bracelet is easy to make, even if you're new to jewelry-making. Thanks to our detailed step-by-step instructions, you'll learn how to mount your beads on an elastic thread, adjust the size to your wrist, and achieve neat finishes. No complex tools are required: just a few beads, a little wire and you're done!

For an impeccable finish, use Crimp beads and Crimp bead covers to secure your beads and achieve a neat result. A Lobster Clasp has been added for a practical finish and an elegant touch to your creation.

steps

★ Step 1/5

Attaching the Lobster Clasp

Cut about 20 cm of wire. Slide a Crimp bead onto one end of the wire, then add your Lobster Clasp. Pass the wire back through the bead to form a loop around the clasp. Using Crimp bead pliers, firmly crush the bead to secure the clasp.



★ Step 2/5

Add a crushable bead mask

Place a crushable bead cover around your crushed bead to hide the finish and give a more aesthetic look.



★ Step 3/5

Closing the bead cover

Using flat-nose pliers or Crimp beads pliers, gently close the bead cover. For more details on this step, please refer to the "Making beautiful finishes with Crimp beads" datasheet, available [here](#).



★ Step 4/5

Stringing the beads

String the natural stone chip beads and the ceramic starfish beads. Alternate chip beads and ceramic star pearls to create a pretty harmony. Here, between 12 and 14 chip beads between each ceramic star.



★ Step 5/5

Finishing the bracelet

To finish your bracelet, repeat steps 1, 2 and 3 on the other end of the wire, this time replacing the Lobster Clasp with an open ring. Your bracelet is finished!
