
steps



★ Step 1/4

To start your bracelet, you'll need to thread 13 sequences (column of numbers) from top to bottom, to obtain an 18cm-long spiral. If you need a larger bracelet, thread 14 sequences. Note that this spiral can be hooked into cast mesh.

Make a beaded chain of 8 beads, close in the round by stitching your hook directly under the 1st bead, which you fold over to the right, bring the bead to be crocheted to the right of the hook, make 1 throw, and pull through the 2 threads on the hook.






★ Step 2/4

This is the beginning of the tube. Check your design carefully and continue.



★ Step 3/4

The required length is reached...My wrist circumference is 16 cms. In principle, you need to add 2 cms to obtain the required length for the bangle.





★ Step 4/4
