#### How to make an anklet

Summer is finally here, and with it, sun, beach and warm sand... To accompany you on your summer escapades, we've designed the <u>Escale à Ibiza</u> collection. A collection of jewelry combining rope, thread, bandanas and laces for a bohemian look reminiscent of Ibiza's hippie markets. We promised you travel and bohemia, so discover<u>Escale à Ibiza</u> 's 5 creations without further ado!

Let's start our journey together with this cord anklet with cowgirl charms and freshwater pearl bracelet. Anklets are a summertime staple and a great way to dress up an outfit, whether during the day or to accessorize an evening ensemble. In this step-by-step tutorial, I'll show you how to make two anklets perfect for summer. The first is made from pink 3mm braided cotton cord and is embellished with cowgirl-style epoxy charms in stainless steel. The stainless steel will ensure that your jewelry stays put all summer long, especially in contact with water and sunlight. The second bracelet is a simple stringing of 8x6mm freshwater beads.

Both bracelets have been designed for an ankle with a circumference of 21.5cm, so remember to adapt the thread/cord dimensions and number of freshwater pearls to suit yours.

These anklets can be customized to suit your tastes and desires! You can choose a different color of <u>braided</u> <u>cotton cord</u> and select <u>different charms</u> from our wide selection, or <u>mix and match them ready-to-use</u>. The hardest part will undoubtedly be choosing!

## Which material to use for Gnkle strap with cowgirl charms and freshwater pearl bracelet?

### **SUPPLIES**



3mm Crimp beads covers - Fine gold Plated x25

Ref.: ACC-896 Quantity: 1



4x0.8mm 316L Stainless Steel Open jump Rings - Gold Tone x10

Ref. : ACX-112 Quantity : 1



3mm braided cotton cord - made in France - Multi rose - Grey x1m

Ref.: CRD-521 Quantity: 1



Stringing wire Gold tone 7 strands 0.30mm x9,2m

Ref.: FC-097 Quantity: 1



Lobster clasp 9 mm 304L gold-finished stainless steel x1

Ref.: FRM-979 Quantity: 2



8x6mm Freshwater pearls irregular olives - Grade A White x15

Ref. : FW-097 Quantity : 1



2mm 316 Stainless Steel Round crimp beads - Gold Tone x25

Ref.: INX-339 Quantity: 1



Flat lace crimp ends 3 mm - 304L gold-plated stainless steel x4

Ref.: INX-344 Quantity: 1



Stainless steel 304L Mix of epoxy charms Western Girly - By Perles&Co - Gold x6

Ref. : SST-942 Quantity : 1



## steps

★ Step 1/8

Start by cutting 30cm of wire, then slip one end into a lace clip. Using flat-nose pliers, close the lace over the braided thread.



★ Step 2/8

Make 5 classic knots, leaving about 3 cm between each one.



★ Step 3/8

Using two pliers, open a ring and slide the charm into it.





★ Step 4/8


Hang it by sliding the ring through the braided wire. I've interspersed the charms as follows:

- disco ball.
- santiag,
- cowboy hat,
- bottle



★ Step 5/8

Add the lace clip to the other end of the cord and close it with a flat clip.



★ Step 6/8

Open a ring with two pliers, then add the Lobster Clasp.



★ Step 7/8

Cut 30cm of wire with wire cutters. Slide a Crimp bead into the wire, then a wire protector, and thread the wire back through the Crimp bead. Using crush bead pliers, crush the bead and fold it in half.





★ Step 8/8

Thread with freshwater beads, then repeat the same step as above to finish the bracelet. Add a ring, then the Lobster Clasp.
