### How to create a summer bracelet with chip beads?

In the mood for vacations, warm sand and salty sea spray? Be inspired by this DIY tutorial to create a seafaring bracelet in pink coral, turquoise and gold. A summery creation that's easy to make, even for beginners, and perfect for accessorizing your beach outfits or extending the vacation vibe into everyday wear!

This trendy jewel features pink coral-tinted bamboo chip beads with a natural, irregular look, reminiscent of seapolished shell fragments. They are combined with turquoise resin beads and pendants, reminiscent of crystal-clear waters. A few golden chip beads in metallic finish add a touch of light, catching the sun and illuminating the wrist. Mounted on a discreet yet resistant transparent nylon turtle thread, this bracelet is comfortable, light and durable. The gold-plated stainless steel Lobster Clasp and open rings guarantee a perfect fit over time, even when exposed to humidity. And with gold-plated Crimp beads and bead covers, the finish is clean and professional. In just a few simple steps and without the need for complex tools, you can create a bracelet inspired by the treasures of the sea, to be worn, given as a gift or declined in several variations.

## Which material to use for Bracelet with coral & turquoise chip beads?

## **SUPPLIES**



3mm Crimp beads covers - Fine gold Plated x25

Ref. : ACC-896 Quantity : 1



9mm 316L stainless steel lobster clasp - Made in Europe - Gold x1

Ref. : ACX-485 Quantity : 1



21x6mm Coral resin pendants - Turquoise x8

Ref. : ARZ-705 Quantity : 1



12x5mm Resin coral beads - Marbled Turquoise x10

Ref. : ARZ-708 Quantity : 1



7 - 10mm irregular chip beads in CCB metallic acrylic - Gold Tone x10

Ref. : CCB-242 Quantity : 1



6-15mm Irregular dyed beads - Sea bamboo chips - Coral Pink x40 cm

Ref.: CHIPS-065 Quantity: 1



Tortue Nylon thread - Transparent 0.30 mm x100m

Ref. : FCÚ-824 Quantity : 1



2mm 316 Stainless Steel Round crimp beads - Gold Tone x25

Ref.: INX-339 Quantity: 1



3x0.6mm 304L stainless steel Open jumprings - Gold x10

Ref. : SST-393 Quantity : 1





★ Step 1/5

Cut about 20 cm of nylon turtle thread. Thread a Crimp bead followed by a closed ring.



Step 2/5

Pass the end of the wire back through the Crimp bead to form a loop around the ring. Leave about 1-2 cm of wire after the bead, then crush it firmly with crush bead pliers or flat-nose pliers. Then add a crushable bead cover for a clean finish, and close it gently with flat-nose pliers.

Step 3/5

Then string the beads in any order you like. The order here is:12 pink coral chip beads / 2 gold chip beads / 4 pink coral chip beads / 2 gold chip beads / 2 small turquoise coral beads / 1 turquoise coral pendant / 1 small turquoise coral bead / 1 turquoise coral pendant / 2 small turquoise coral beads / 2 gold chip beads / 9 beads chips pink coral / 2 beads chips gold / 2 small beads turquoise coral / 1 pendant turquoise coral / 1 small beads turquoise coral / 1 pendant turquoise coral / 2 small beads turquoise coral / 2 beads chips gold / 12 beads chips pink coral



Step 4/5

Finish by threading a Crimp bead followed by an open ring (the one you'll use to secure your clasp). As in step 2, pass the thread back through the crush bead, then crush it as before.

Then add a crush bead cover for a clean finish, and close it gently with flat-nose pliers.





Attach the Lobster Clasp to the open ring by opening it with pliers, then close tightly.

To open and close your bracelet on a daily basis, simply hook the lobster clasp onto the closed ring at the other end.
