

# Which material to use for Orange bandana necklace with worked beads?

## **SUPPLIES**

12x2mm 316L Stainless Steel Open jump Rings - Gold Tone x10

Ref. : ACX-113 Quantity : 1



8x1mm 316L stainless steel jumprings open - Gold x10

Ref. : ACX-578 Quantity : 1



Bandana 100% cotton - Cashmere pattern - Orange x1

Ref. : COU-633 Quantity : 1



12x1.40mm 304 Stainless Steel Open Round Twisted jump Rings - Gold Tone x10

Ref.: INX-430 Quantity: 1



10x2mm 304 stainless steel round striated open jump rings - Gold Tone x10

Ref.: INX-436 Quantity: 1



24x8mm Stainless steel 316L Shark tooth pendant - Gold x1

Ref. : SST-241 Quantity : 1



10x5mm Stainless steel 304L large hole Beads - Gold x5

Ref. : SST-269 Quantity : 1



10x8mm 304L stainless steel Heishi roundelle beads - Gold x5

Ref.: SST-318 Quantity: 1



10mm 304L stainless steel lobster clasp extension chain and drop - Gold x1

Ref. : STL-264 Quantity : 1



# steps

# ★ Step 1/13

Start by cutting the bandana about 7cm wide along the grain. If you're cutting a bandana for the first time, check out our video on how to cut a bandana.



## ★ Step 2/13

Then fold the two ends over the center.



# ★ Step 3/13

Fold in half, keeping the cut ends inside.







## ★ Step 4/13

Start threading beads and rings: here I've threaded a fairly large bead at the first end, followed by 4 worked rings and a double ring.





## ★ Step 5/13

Then continue threading, alternating single and twisted rings.





#### ★ Step 6/13

Add the shark tooth pendant. To do this, open a simple ring using flat-nose pliers, slide on the pendant and close the ring. You can then slide the ring onto the bandana as with the previous ones.

Do the same on the other side, symmetrically.





## ★ Step 7/13

Once you've finished threading the beads and rings. Take one end of the bandana and slip on a single ring.





★ Step 8/13

We'll start by tying a knot into which we'll wedge the ring. Start by passing the end along the length of the bandana.



★ Step 9/13

Then pass the end underneath, as if to roll up the length of the bandana.



★ Step 10/13

Pass the end inside this "wrap" to form a knot.





★ Step 11/13

Then tighten by adjusting the knot.



★ Step 12/13

Do the same on the other side.



★ Step 13/13

Add a clasp with an extension chain for easy size adjustment.
