How to make a bracelet from delica?

Want to create a unique, elegant piece of jewelry that's easy to wear every day? This tutorial is for you. Today we'll be making a simple bracelet with Miyuki Delica beads, ideal for adding a touch of color and style to your wrist. With its delicate central knot and fine lines, this handmade piece of jewelry is as seductive in its simplicity as it is in its originality. Whether you're a beginner or a hobby enthusiast, you'll love the technique: accessible, relaxing and full of possibilities.

This beaded bracelet is fully customizable, so you'll be able to create whatever you like. You can play with the number of strands to obtain a finer or more assertive style, and vary the shades ad infinitum according to your preferences. Simply choose your colors from our wide range of [Delica 8/0](#). If you're looking for a more delicate, discreet look, [Delica 11/0](#) or [Delica 15/0](#) would be perfect for a more discreet piece of jewelry. To ensure optimum comfort, I've opted for a clasp with an extension chain, enabling the bracelet to be adapted to all wrists. This little detail makes it practical, elegant and, above all, ideal for giving.

Jumpings open 5x0.7mm 316L gold-finished stainless steel x10
Ref. : ACC-736

Miyuki Delica 8/0 DBL0723 - Opaque Red x8g

0.30mm Invisible nylon cord - illusion cord - Griffin - Transparent x50m

1.5x1.5mm 316 Stainless Steel Crimp Tubes - Gold Tone x25

4 mm knot covers with closed rings - 304L Stainless Steel Gold x4

10mm 304L stainless steel lobster clasp extension chain and drop - Gold x1

steps

★ Step 1/2

Thread the knot cover over the longer end of the wire. Then pass the short piece of wire through the hole in the knot cover. Do not flatten yet.



★ Step 2/2

Then thread on another Crimp bead.
